HOLIDAY HARBOUR MARINA - 2009

RULES, REGULATIONS & VARIOUS INFORMATION:

BOOKING/DEPOSITS: Beginning in 2009, we will be requiring the following:

1. All dockage must have at least a 50% deposit paid down on the well when booking. The balance may be paid upon arrival at the Marina.
2. In order for our office staff to complete Transient Slips ahead of time, we will require the name, address and telephone number of the boater; the name of the boat; its numbers, length and width - (this, of course, will allow us to place you accordingly). Also, if you have any preferences as to where you would like to be docked, please let us know and we will try our best to accommodate you. Once again, we will do whatever we can but cannot guaranty requested wells - it is a first come, first served basis and the earlier we are advised of your wishes, the better the chances are for a selected well and/or area.

When in a large group, Transient Slips must be completed in advance, faxed and forwarded along with a deposit of \$200.00 down on the anticipated stay. This down payment will be refunded after the group has arrived.

Fleet Captains can let us know of how many members they are expecting to be attending and we can fax copies of the Transient Slips and your Fleet Captain can fill in the information; collect the funds and forward them on to us ahead of time.

Any boaters wishing to pay for their entire stay in advance are more than welcome to therefore saving them the trouble of having to do so when they arrive.

NOTE: When making your reservation, we need your name, boat name, length of boat and width of boat, along with expected time of arrival.

ELECTRICITY:

Please be advised that when you are in port great care must be taken not to overuse the electrical power available. This is especially important when large groups of boaters are in with a group. This puts a great strain on the power supply and leads to outages.

We would ask that you cooperate with one another and try to cut down on unessential usage. Please keep in mind, that even the smallest appliances etc., when in a large group, takes a great toll on the electrical power supply.

POOL RULES & REGULATIONS:

The pool is now a salt water pool and is available for your enjoyment. It is open from 9:00 am until 9:00 pm.

NOTE: The pool is an unsupervised pool and therefore any bathers under 12 years of age are not permitted unless they are accompanied by an adult or someone 16 years of age or older.

No glass containers are allowed in the pool area.

Maximum number of bathers in the pool at one time is ten and boisterous play in or about the pool is prohibited. Masks and floating devices should not be used.

There is an emergency telephone located in the lobby of the Clubhouse and a First Aid Kit is available in the Office of the Clubhouse.

Persons infected with communicable diseases or having open sores on his or her body shall not enter the pool.

CLUBHOUSE WASHROOMS AND SHOWERS:

The Clubhouse is equipped with showers and washrooms for your use. We only ask for cooperation in keeping them clean.

RECYCLING:

There are recycling bins located at the southeast corner of the Marina adjacent to the entry gate.

ICE:

Just to the left from the Clubhouse (coming from the Marina) is an Ice Machine for your use. We sell ice by the block and by the bag.
